Description	The proposed activity is to teach a forensic archaeological field school in a secluded place in the Dr. Paul E. Martin Center for Field Studies and Environmental Education in the Bath Nature Preserve. The goal of the course is to teach students how forensic archaeologists conduct themselves at crime scenes involving the clandestine burials of murdered victims. A very realistic mock crime scene is prepared a year before the course is taught. After one year, students will excavate it and learn the techniques necessary to participate in prehistoric, historic and forensic archaeological investigations, excavations and analysis.
