Description	We will trap and search for a different group of vertebrates for each of three weeks. Trapping will include: minnow traps for fish and amphibian larvae, hoop traps for turtles and fish (in Garden and Windhover ponds), and Sherman traps for mammals (18 Acres/Grandview Alley, South Woods). Our goal is to introduce students to the vertebrate diversity of northeastern Ohio as well as to introduce common techniques to locate, capture, identify, and document observations of vertebrates.
