I intend to collect wolf spiders (family Lycosidae, e.g., Tigrosa helluo), common orbweaving spiders (family Araneidae, e.g., Araneus diadematus), and grass spiders (family Agelenidae, e.g., Agelenopsis pennsylvanica) from the Field Station and Bath Nature Preserve in northeast Ohio. My proposed activities involve hand collection and the use of non-lethal traps to obtain live specimens for behavioral and morphological research. The goals of this work are to study variation in spider fang structure, silk usage, and webinteraction behavior across species and habitats. This research will contribute to a better understanding of the ecological roles and adaptations of native spider species. Collection will be done minimally and ethically, with no lasting impact on local populations or habitats, and in a way that supports broader conservation and educational outreach efforts associated with the Field Station.
